

## # 408– Butternut ( *Juglans cinerea* )

<b>Hardiness Zone:</b>	5-8
<b>Mature Height:</b>	50-70 feet
<b>Features:</b>	The Butternut Walnut tree, <i>Juglans cinerea</i> , is often called the 'white walnut tree' that grows into a large cold hardy tree that produces oval wrinkled nuts with a mild, delicious kernels impacted with oil and a spicy rich flavor that is useful to use in baking, candy making or eating raw.
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun; moist, well drained soil;
<b>Growth Rate:</b>	Slow
<b>Mature Form:</b>	Rounded
