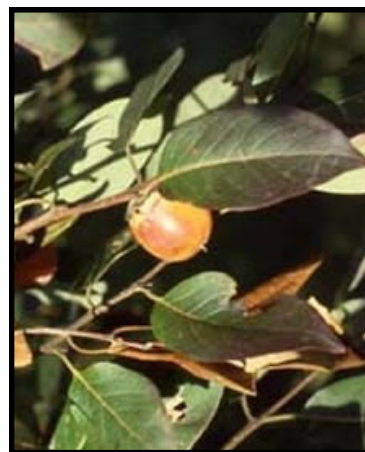


410– Persimmon (*Diospyros virginiana*)

Hardiness Zone:	5-9
Mature Height:	35-60 feet
Features:	Dark green summer foliage that changes to yellow or reddish-purple in autumn: pale orange fruit (on female trees) in fall, edible upon ripening (after frost) thick, blocky bark.
Culture:	Full sun; moist, well-drained soil, but tolerant of drought; ph adaptable.
Growth Rate:	Slow to Medium
Mature Form:	Oval
