

415– Eastern Redbud (*Cercis Canadensis*)

Hardiness Zone:	5-8
Mature Height:	20-30 feet
Features:	Bright, magenta pink flowers in spring, produced in large quantity; yellow fall color; mildly shaggy bark shows up well in winter.
Culture:	Full sun to partial shade; moist, well-drained soil (trees in full sun may need more water); tolerates alkaline soils.
Growth Rate:	Fast
Mature Form:	Rounded to broad spreading, often taking on a picturesque form.
