Features:	Cooks love these easy-to-crack, small, sweet kernels. Can be used as a shrub-like landscape plant. Likes well-drained, loamy soil . Flower Color: Female is red and male is yellowish brown.

Mature Form:	10-12 ' spread, multi-stemmed shrub with a rounded top and an open, often wide-
