

422– Pee Gee Hydrangea (hy-DRAIN-jah) (*Hydrangea paniculata*)

Hardiness Zone:	4-8
Mature Height:	10-15 feet
Features:	Large pyramidal clusters of white flowers in summer; flower color changes to pinkish white in late summer and light brown in autumn.
Culture:	Grow in moist, but well-drained soil, in sun to partial shade. Blooms on current season's wood; may be cut back to a few buds to form a framework in spring to produce larger flowers, or alternately, allow to grow with minimal pruning.
Growth Rate:	Fast
Mature Form:	Upright to irregular
