

424– Strawberry Bush/Wahoo (*Euonymus americana*)

Hardiness Zone:	6-9
Mature Height:	4-6 feet
Features:	Excellent ornamental species. The leaves turn dark red in autumn. The red capsules and scarlet arillate seeds add to the “burning effect.” Large specimens can have hundreds of “bursting” red capsules. In the winter, the bright green twigs are also attractive.
Culture:	Best in partial-to-full sun, but are shade tolerant. Occurs in moist forests, including bottomland hardwood forests and adjacent to small streams. Once established, it can tolerate poor drainage or moderate droughts and alkaline terrain.
