

American Beech (*Fagus grandifolia*)

Hardiness Zone:	4-9
Mature Height:	80 feet
Features:	Easily recognized from a distance by its smooth, steel-gray bark and tapering surface roots at the base of its trunk with a short trunk and a rounded to spreading shape It is a climax tree in mature forests
Culture:	Part to Full Sun, adaptable to organic or clay soils, of alkaline to acidic pH, and of very moist to dry conditions. However, it prefers rich soils that are well-drained with constant moisture
Growth Rate:	Slow
Mature Form:	Short trunk, rounded to spreading
